2024 BURSARY: UNDERGRADUATE INTERNATIONAL SADC STUDENTS

This Bursary is aimed at Stellenbosch University enrolled International Undergraduate students, from the SADC (Southern African Development Community) region [Angola, Botswana, Comoros, DRCongo, Lesotho, Madagascar, Malawi, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia, Seychelles, Swaziland (Eswatini), Tanzania, Zambia, Zimbabwe] who is in their 2nd, 3rd or 4th year of studies (of a four-year-programme) in 2024.

Who Qualifies for the Bursary?

The following criteria, in no order of preference, will be considered in the allocation of bursaries:

- Financially needy applicants whose combined household income is not more than R350 000 per annum
- Have passed at least 60% of the credits for the previous academic year (2023).
- Not to be used towards historical debt.
- Primarily towards covering study fees component.
- Clear indication of co-funding (mainly for accommodation or having cleared debt).
- Aimed at supporting students who are on track to complete their degrees within the minimum years, but consideration may also be given to those on track to complete within n+1 years.
- Students should also have a valid study permit/refugee/asylum seeker for the full academic year or VFS receipt confirming your application for a valid visa.
- Only applicable to Permanent Resident Holders who do not qualify for NSFAS funding
- Students should apply annually the award is not renewed automatically.

Bursaries Available:

Amount of Award is R50 000 each

- > 2nd Year of studies = 20 bursaries
- > 3rd Year of studies = 30 bursaries
- ➤ 4th Year of studies = 15 bursaries
