

COMPOSITION OF THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE OF DONORS TO STELLENBOSCH UNIVERSITY

The electoral college of donors to Stellenbosch University consists of:

1. All donors (individuals) who were members of this electoral college on 9 May 2016.
2. All donors (individuals) who have since donated R25 000 or more to SU. Individuals achieve voting status for every R25 000 donated; i.e. if a person has donated R100 000 he/she will be entitled to cast four votes during an election.
3. All companies or other institutions who donated more than R250 000 to SU in the last three years. Companies achieve a vote for each multiple of R250 000 donated over the last three years; i.e. a company who donated R1 million will be entitled to cast four votes during an election. If a company/institution failed to donate a minimum of R250 000 over the last three years, it forfeits the right to vote.

Nota bene:

- (a) The donations in 1 – 3 can be in the form of cash, property or something else as long as the monetary value of the donation is quantifiable.
- (b) In the case of individuals, no member of the electoral college of donors will be denied membership if the Council should on occasion raise the requirement for donations.
- (c) The SU Foundation will request companies/institutions that qualify for membership of the electoral college to indicate which person in the relevant company/institution will vote during an election process of Councillors by donors.
- (d) The rules for qualifying as a member of the electoral college of donors must be revised every five years.
