Guidelines for Submission of Manuscripts

You are invited to submit an abstract(s) with a maximum of two abstracts per author for the Defence Organisation & Resource Management Conference 2024, by 1 May 2024 for approval by the Scientific Committee. You will be notified by 15 May 2024 if your abstract has been accepted. The submission date for the full paper is 30 June 2024. Submitted papers will go through a peer review process and authors will be notified of the outcome by 20 July 2024. Please adhere to the full paper final submission date of 30 June 2024. Authors will be able to present the paper during the conference in person/face-to-face ONLY.

Student submissions can be in the form of a full/draft paper (including an abstract of no more than 500 words and a cover page with details of the author(s)) or in the form of a 500 word abstract with a cover page.
