Executive Treasurer and Chairperson of Treasurer's Forum Term Report 1

Preamble or background

My term of treasurer and chairperson of the treasurer's forum started on 16 March 2022.

The Treasurer is the chief financial officer of the student parliament executive committee and is at least responsible for ensuring that the financial resources of the student parliament is used in a transparent, responsible, and sustainable manner. Activities

Remarks
