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Every year, Stellenbosch University attracts top achievers. Look around you – most of you have a matric aggregate of above 75%. Our surveys show that the No. 1 reason students give for coming to Stellenbosch is our academic reputation – and correctly so: The best students apply and the best are accepted. No wonder we are ranked in the top 1% of universities worldwide.

And because we have many international students coming to Stellenbosch, you will be studying with them. Enjoy this diverse setting!

- Japie van Zyl, 'n ruimte-ingenieur by NASA ... en Matie-alumnus.
