SUMMARY REPORT FOR CREATIVE OUTPUTS AND INNOVATIONS SUBMISSIONS, 2020

1. Introduction

South African universities annually submit their creative outputs and innovations subsidy claims to the Department of Higher Education and Training (the Department) for evaluation and allocation of subsidy. All submissions must meet the requirements stipulated in the *Policy on the Evaluation of Creative Outputs and Innovations Produced by Higher Education Institutions* (2017) and the *Implementation Guidelines* (2019). The policy recognises quality creative research outputs; evaluated outputs are used as proxy for research, thus the subsidy to universities. The policy covers the following sub-fields: *Fine and Visual Arts; Music; Theatre; Performance and Dance; Design; Film and Television and Literary Arts*. For innovations, the policy recognises: *Patents and Plant Breeder's Rights*.

The Department together with the National Research Foundation (NRF) have developed the Research Outputs Submission System (ROSS), for capturing all research outputs produced by universities. To ensure quality of the evaluation process, submitted creative research outputs and innovations are evaluated by field-specific panel of experts using pre-determined evaluation requirements in line with the policy and the policy and *Implementation Guidelines* (2019) developed for this purpose.

Approved submitted outputs may be allocated either 1 or 2 units. However, the final unit allocation is based on author/contributor proportion. This report presents the outcomes of creative research outputs and innovations for the 2020 submission cycle.

2. University Submissions and Units Awarded

The university submitted a total of fifty-six (56) items in 2020 for subsidy claims. Of the fifty-six (56) submitted items, thirty-nine (39) were for creative outputs, and seventeen (17) in innovations. A total of 38.0916 units were awarded. Table 1 indicates the number of approved and declined items and units awarded per subfield.

The university outcomes of the evaluations, is summarised as follows:

Design

The university submitted 5 items for evaluations. Following the evaluations, 3 items were approved and 2 were declined. A total of 2.285 units were awarded for the approved items. The 2 declined items, along with its reason(s) are listed in table 2.

Fine Arts

The university submitted 4 items for evaluations. Following the evaluations, 3 items were approved and 1 was declined. A total of 6 units were awarded for the approved items. The 1 declined item, along with its reason(s) are listed in table 2.

Literary Arts

The university submitted 5 items for evaluations. Following the evaluations, 2 items were approved and 3 were declined. A total of 4 units were awarded for the approved items. The 3 declined items, along with its reason(s) are listed in table 2.

Music

The university submitted 16 items for evaluations. Following the evaluations, 15 items were approved and 1 was declined. A total of 14.16 units were awarded for the approved items. The 1 declined item, along with its reason(s) are listed in table 2.

Theatre, Performance and Dance

The university submitted 9 items for evaluations. Following the evaluations, 6 items were approved and 3 were declined. A total of 6 units were awarded for the approved items. The 3 declined items, along with its reason(s) are listed in table 2.

Innovations

The university submitted 17 items for evaluations. Following the evaluations, 7 items were approved and 10 were declined. A total of 5.6466 units were awarded for the approved items. The 3 declined items, along with its reason(s) are listed in table 2.

3. Recommendation

The Department has noted an increase and compliance in the overall submissions received from the university. To ensure continued improvement from institutions, the Department recommends the following:

- Should ensure that there is significant recontextualization of creative works and this should be demonstrated in the applicant annotation, and the creative output.
- Should ensure that peer reviewers are familiar with the Implementation Guidelines (2019) and the policy.
- Should ensure not to source 2 peer reviewers for one item from the same institution, but rather ensure a wide reach in their use of peer reviewers.
- Should ensure that all required documentation listed in the implementation guidelines for innovations (2019) are provided thus ensuring compliance.
